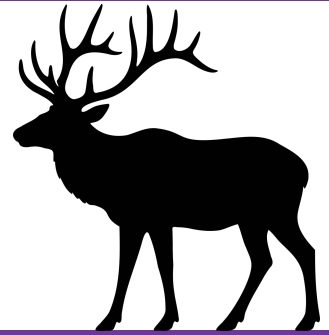

Garden Grove Elks Amateur Radio Club (GGEARC) Expands Outreach and Capabilities at the Lodge

The Garden Grove Elks Amateur Radio Club (GGEARC), proudly based at the Garden Grove Elks Lodge, continues to strengthen its role as a hub for public relations and publicity communication as well as community service for the Lodge and the Orange Coast District.

The club operates a fully equipped ham radio station on Lodge property, featuring a prominent radio tower with multiple antennas and several radios housed within the on-site "ham shack." Recent and continuing upgrades to the tower and antenna systems have significantly enhanced transmission capabilities, ensuring reliable communication locally, regionally and nationally.

Membership is currently encouraged among Elks members and their friends throughout the Orange Coast District. Access to the station is open to all licensed amateur radio operators within the District and their friends, providing a collaborative environment for both experienced operators and newcomers.

In addition to regular radio operations, club members are committed to supporting fellow Elks in obtaining their amateur radio licenses. Through mentorship and guidance, the club helps individuals navigate licensing requirements and develop practical communication skills. Looking ahead, the Garden Grove Amateur Radio Club is focused on expanding its role in disaster preparedness. In the near future the Club has plans to coordinate with the City of Garden Grove to provide emergency communication support during critical situations, and reinforcing the importance of amateur radio as a resilient and reliable communication resource.

The club also highlights amateur radio as an excellent hobby for young people, offering hands-on experience in electronics. By engaging the next generation, the organization aims to inspire future innovators and skilled communicators, in addition to encouraging membership in the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

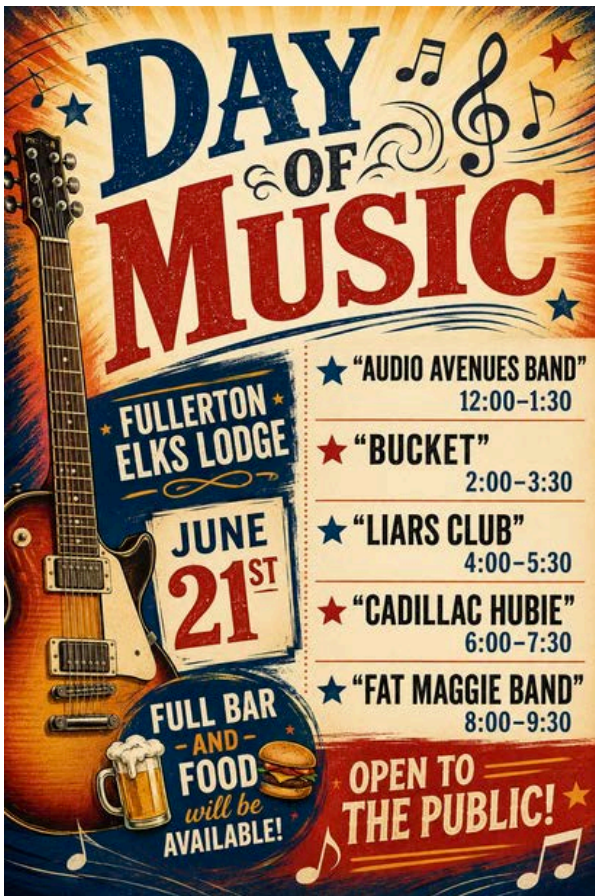
